Brillantmont is a boarding and day school for boys and girls aged 12-18 in the center of Lausanne. Founded in 1882 and still owned by the founding family, it offers programmes which prepare the students to enter universities throughout the world. The student body is very international with over 35 different countries represented. The small size of the school (90 boarders, 50 day students) permits close teacher contact and encourages a sense of community.

During the school year the students study in:

- the British Section: Years 9-13 leading to IGCSE, AS and A Level examinations
- the American Section: Grades 8-12 leading to the High School Graduation Diploma
- the Language Section: for a complete term of full school year in order to learn several foreign languages

- the Swiss Tenth Year: a programme of languages and computing for students from the German speaking area of Switzerland

The teaching is in English, but all students learn French, the host language and several other foreign languages are offered. Class sizes are limited to 15 and personalized timetables allow students to develop their strengths. Monthly progress reports stimulate learning and set new goals for achievement.

Wireless connections throughout the school ensure technology is integrated into classroom content. A private password allows parents to access their child's reports, schedule and homework on our interactive, three-dimensional website.

A wide variety of extra-curricular activities and sports teams take place every day

after class in order for students to develop their own interests. Weekly excursions and cultural trips allow students to discover different aspects of Switzerland and neighbouring countries.

Boarding accommodation is of an excellent standard with resident teachers who strive to create a "home from home." Day students can use our morning pick-up service at Lausanne station and are welcome to eat lunch at school.

A summer school to learn intensive French or English with sports and excursions takes place in July and August for 11- 17 year olds.
